Minutes from the 2013 Term Four Meeting held 24th October at Hillcrest High School:

Items for Discussion:

WMA Web Site: Pam said she together with Mark are still working on it. There are still a few areas to deal with. (Currently it is a work in progress)

Finances: Mark tabled a document outlining the finances of the association. It contained all transactions over the past year. It was noted there was a drop in income. This was the result of less Schol days offered – only half of 2012. There has also been a reduction in grants. The Waimaths competition is now more expensive to run, a result of an increase in size and more hireage of equipment needed. It was suggested there was a cutback in prizes offered. It was put "That the financial statement tabled by Mark be accepted as a true and accurate account".

Schol Days: Only one Schol Day was offered this year which was Calculus. Approximately 60 attended. Stats was not offered, Ann believes the demand is high. A few names were suggested as possibilities for assistance for this to be offered in 2014. The cost of Schol days for 2014 has yet to be finalised.

Waimaths: (Anita, who currently has responsibility for this placed an apology) Anita asked via another member present if it was okay to use the same write as last year. The rule was reiterated "That no calculators are permitted at Y7 – 8 of Waimaths." The motion was put "That we at stay with the current writer for Waimaths 2014.

Moved: Chair Carried (All)

There was more discussion on the preparation of questions so answers are in accordance with the current policy of no calculators. This policy was set last year and WMA went to considerable lengths to ensure all participating schools were aware. Motion was put "That there will be no calculators permitted at Y7 – 8 for the 2014 Waimaths Competition"

It needs to be made clear that at Y9 - 11 there are no cell phones. The question was asked if Graphics Calculators are permitted. It was decided they are acceptable for now. (This may be dependent on the checking of questions).

The entering of data could be more streamlined and Mark said he will look at the possibility of using Google Docs for this task.

The cost of membership was discussed. The motion was put "That we recommend at the AGM that membership costs increase as follows: High Schools and Areas Schools increase to \$100. Intermediate Schools increase to \$50. Primary and individual membership to stay the same.

AGM: The date for this has been set as **14**th **November.** The venue is currently down as Sacred Heart Girls College. (Pam to investigate availability). Start time is 4.30pm. For PD: Ingrid received an email from Judy Bailey who has offered to do a session. Ingrid will reply to discuss curriculum levels of her PD. It is thought level 3 -4 would be beneficial. Recipients of grants who attended the most recent NZAMT conference in Wellington have/will be contacted to see who is available to offer a session. This is in accordance with their grant. Ingrid has said she will email these recipients again.

Christine will do the final details of PD offered in the AGM, and Ingrid to assist in the coordination.

NZAMT: Ingrid said the next NZAMT conference to be in Auckland 2015. The annual writers camp will also be in Auckland during January.
